BASE31 PACKAGES FAQs

IS THERE A TIME LIMIT FOR THE SELF-GUIDED GROUNDS WALKING TOUR?

We recommend visitors allow 60-75 minutes to fully enjoy the self-guided grounds tour. The accompanying listening devices and site maps must be returned to the Visitor Centre by its closing time daily, which will be shared with you at the beginning of your tour.

WHAT WILL I SEE ON THE GROUNDS WALKING TOURS?

You will get to see the exterior of nearly all of the 40+ World War II era structures still standing at Base31, which represents the last of the original 231 British Commonwealth Air Training Plan sites standing to this extent in all of Canada. You will also see some public art, gardens, and history plaques.

HOW FAR ARE THE GROUNDS WALKING TOURS?

The Grounds Walking Tours cover nearly 70 acres, so we recommend comfortable shoes and clothing appropriate for the weather. You can rent a golf cart or a bicycle to take if you wish.

WHAT WILL I SEE ON THE GUIDED EXHIBITION HALL TOUR?

The Exhibition Hall in Hangar 1 has several thematic exhibits and engaging activities for all ages that explore the rich 14,000 year human history of Base31, including aircraft and large-scale models.

WHERE IS THE LANCASTER BOMBER AND HOW CAN I SEE IT?

Lancaster Bomber KB 882 on loan from the National Air Force Museum of Canada is in the Exhibition Hall located in Hangar 1. It is included in the Guided Exhibition Hall Tours.

IF I AM RENTING A VENUE AS PART OF MY VISIT TO BASE31, HOW CAN I COORDINATE WITH STAFF TO ADD ON A HISTORY GROUP EXPERIENCE?

ARE THERE RESTROOMS AVAILABLE DURING THE GROUNDS AND EXHIBITION HALL TOURS?

Yes - there are restrooms at the beginning and end of the Grounds Tours and at the Exhibition Hall.

ARE THE GROUNDS WALKING TOURS WEATHER-DEPENDENT?

We've delivered tours rain or shine, but they will be rescheduled or reworked if there is serious weather.

ARE HISTORY GROUP EXPERIENCES SEASONAL?

Yes - Grounds Walking Tours begin in May when our Visitor Centre opens and Exhibition Hall Tours begin in July. History Group Experiences are on offer until November due to the seasonality of our largely outdoors site.
